The publishers of *Stock Car Racing* created *Open Wheel* Magazine to cover American oval-track racing with open-wheel cars, including Sprint, Midget, Mini-Sprint, Supermodified, and Indy cars. *Open Wheel* made its debut in summer of 1980 with issue No. 1. The first three issues were not dated. Bimonthly publication commenced in early 1982. In 1988 *Open Wheel* shifted to monthly publication, which continued until December 2001. *Open Wheel* survived for six more months as a supplement to *Stock Car Racing*.

This index includes subjects of full-length articles and of columns that focus on a single topic. Brief mentions or photos of persons and subjects are not listed. The 2002 supplements to *Stock Car Racing* are not indexed.
